## Changing Your Wi-Fi Name & Password

If you wish to change the name and/or password of your Wi-Fi signal instead of using the details on the bottom of the router, simply follow the steps below:

• Open your browser and navigate to the following web address: http://192.168.1.1 – you will be presented with the following log in screen:

In the password box, type in **tp-link1996** and click on the 'Log in' button. You should then be logged in to the router admin interface. (**Please note**, if you have previously changed the default password from tp-link1996 then you will need to use the updated settings you chose to use at that time instead)

- Click 'Basic at the top of the screen and then click on Wireless down the left-side menu
- Set the Network Name (SSID) to a name of your choice and set your password on the 2.4GHz Wireless Network
