



Website Terms and Conditions

These Terms of Use govern access to and use of our website found at (the "Site"). By accessing and using the Site, you agree to be bound by these Terms of Use. If you do not agree with any part of the following, please do not use the Site.

We reserve the right to change these Terms of Use at any time. Amendments will take effect when posted on our Site. You agree that it is your responsibility to be aware of any changes made to these Terms of Use.

A. Definitions in this agreement

1. **"Internet"** means the global data network comprising interconnected networks using Transmission Control Protocol/Internet Protocol;
2. **"Site"** means the website found at broadband.yourcoop.coop ;
3. **"OurCoop" and "we" and "our" and "us"** means Central England Co-operative Limited, a registered society under the Co-operative & Community Benefit Societies Act 2014 with registered number 10143R and whose registered office is at Central House, Queen Street, Lichfield, WS13 6QD
4. **"you" and "your"** means you, the person entering into this agreement with OurCoop;

B. Your Obligations

1. You agree that you will only access and use the Site in accordance with these Terms of Use and in accordance with and subject at all times to all applicable laws and regulations anywhere subsisting in the world. 2.
